The Board of Liberty County Commissioners met in regular session on the above stated date at 10:00 AM in their room at the Courthouse. Those present were: Chairman Rlynn Rockman, Commissioner Larry Hendrickson, and Commissioner Russ Tempel.

WORKMANS COMPENSATION

Update on injured road crew employee ("D.R.") from case worker and physician states his condition is unchanged from last report.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

Marc Holmes was in to discuss road issues. We suggested that Marc's crew build / fabricate a steel form to pour concrete foundations for cattle guards. Time permitting, they should also build a few cattle guards for spring installation (one at Pugsley's and one near Fritz's).

COUNCIL ON AGING

Commissioner Rockman attended the monthly Council on Aging meeting. Treasurer's report = \$25,280. CTEP public hearing will be December 11th to discuss enhancement project at Liberty County Senior Center. The three year terms for Gary Jensen, Bill Gunderson, and Betty Marshall are up.

TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Commissioner Rockman attended the quarterly TAC meeting. The recent compliance review went well. Glenda and Sheila completed the mandatory drug / alcohol seminar in Helena. The bus rodeo was attended by Delbert Anderson and Rhonda Emerson, who placed 4th and 14th respectively (out of 30 participating drivers). Glenda is working on grants for Fiscal Year 2015, updating Title VI policies, and will apply for a new bus in 2016.

CJIBUS ISSUE

Thadd Kaiser, CJI superintendent, stopped in to report that the Joplin Post Office requested that the school bus no longer load / unload students in their parking lot due to liability issues. The Commissioner's and Kaiser drove to Joplin and decided the bus will now stop west of the post office and south of the park on county property. Marc Holmes was notified of this decision, so his crew can maintain snow removal in this location throughout the winter months.

LIBERTY COUNTY INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT 2

This revised agreement for incarceration of adult prisoners between Hill and Liberty County's was re-submitted for signatures. We had approved this agreement on 11-19-2013 (see minutes on that date).

LIBERTY MEDICAL CENTER ANNUAL MEETING

Commissioner Hendrickson attended the annual Liberty Medical Center meeting on November 20th. New board members elected are Merlin Wolery and Morb Wicks.

LIBERTY COUNTY TRANSIT

Glenda Hanson stopped in for approval of policies. A motion was made by Commissioner Tempel, and seconded by Commissioner Hendrickson to adopt a Title VI policy (which is MDOT's policy, including people of LEP "Limited English Proficiency"). The motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hendrickson and seconded by Commissioner Tempel to authorize Glenda to apply for Transit operating funds of \$81,660.23 for fiscal year 2015, including a contingency fund of around \$20,000. The motion carried.

SAGE CREEK COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

We received recommendations for three re-appointments to the Sage Creek County Water District, namely, John Cicon, Bryon Wolery, and Elvin Sundgren. A motion was made by Commissioner Tempel and seconded by Commissioner Rockman to approve these appointees through December 2017. The motion carried.

AGRICULTURAL COVENANT

Hugh Brown offered an Ag Covenant for the Layton Coulee Farms in Twn 31 North, Range 6 East, M.P.M. A motion was made by Commissioner Hendrickson, and seconded by Commissioner Rockman to approve this covenant. The motion carried.

SENIOR CENTER

While delivering "Meals-on-Wheels" in Joplin in one of our transit vans, driver Tom Ludwig clipped the left fender / front bumper of the van. The accident was due to poor visibility and icy roads. The Commissioners looked at the damage and called Snyder's Dent Shop for an estimate. No personal injuries or damage to other property was sustained.
